## SICK POLICIES

This is just a reminder. Please refer to your parent handbook for a more detailed list of symptoms.

Sometimes symptoms may not seem too severe to keep your child home, but BTELC has the following policy in place for the protection of all children and staff.

Any child with diarrhea, vomiting or fever of 100 degrees or above will be classified as "sick". The parent will be called to pick their child up from the Early Learning Center immediately. Children must be free of diarrhea, vomiting or fever free (without medicine) for 24 hours before they may return to school.
